# Play Dough

**Prep Time**  
5 minutes

**Total Time**  
10 minutes

## Equipment Needed

- Mixing bowl
- Ziploc (or similar) quart size bag

## Ingredients

- 1 cup flour
- 2 tsp cream of tartar
- 1/2 cup salt
- 1 packet Kool-Aid  
(FOR A RICHER COLOR USE 2 PACKETS)
- 1 tsp vegetable oil  
(TO KEEP COLOR DO NOT USE OLIVE OIL)
- 3/4 cup water

## Instructions

- 1 - Place all the dry ingredients in the Ziploc bag.
- 2 - In the bowl, stir together the water and oil.
- 3 - Carefully add the water mixture to the bag and seal - forcing out most of the air.
- 4 - Squeeze the bag, kneading the dough until the color is uniform and dough is soft and smooth (approx. 3-5 minutes). You may have to reopen to bag to let more air out as you knead.
- 5 - Turn the contents of the bag inside out onto a piece of wax paper (or similar). Continue to knead the play dough until it is a consistency that you can mold into shapes. Some find it fun to just pick it up and squeeze it around in their hands to knead it.

NOTE: If your dough is too sticky - add more flour; too clumpy or dry - add a little more water.



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
