A GAME THAT WILL HELP YOU TO RECOGNIZE DIFFERENT DENOMINATIONS OF CURRENCY WHILE ALLOWING YOU TO COUNT, ADD AND TRADE MONEY.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Printed play money
- Pencil/pen and paper
- One die
(that's a single dice)


If you don't have any dice - print off the dice pattern from our First Citizens Power Saver Activity page and make your own!

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Print the play money and cut apart. Each player gets a blank sheet of paper and puts their name at the top.
2. Appoint one person to be banker, they are in charge of the money.
3. Each number on the die represents that number of dollars. Take turns rolling the die and adding the dollars together until one person reaches $\$ 100$. (For example: you roll the die and it lands on a three, that means $\$ 3$ and you place that amount on your sheet and collect $\$ 3$ from the banker. Next turn you roll a six, you add six to your total and collect $\$ 6$ more dollars. As you get more $\$ \mathbf{\$}$ you can trade it in for bigger denominations from the banker. Example: five \$1 for a $\$ \mathbf{5}$ bill and two $\$ 5$ for a $\$ 10$.)
4. This continues until one of the players reaches $\$ 100$. Not a lotoff time? Play to $\mathbf{\$ 5 0}$ or for a SUPER QUICK game just $\mathbf{\$ 2 5}$ !
