SNOW VOLCANO

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Snow
Baking Soda
Warm Water
Dish Soap
Vinegar
Food Coloring
Plastic Cup or Bottle

TIP: Have PLENTY of baking soda and vinegar ready because the kids will want to do this again and again! You can also change the food coloring color to make a rainbow of snow volcanoes!

STEP #1:

In a tall cup or plastic bottle, add 1 tbsp of dish soap, fill halfway with baking soda and mix in 1/4 cup of warm water. **TIP:** Using a bottle with a narrow opening, you may get your "snow lava" to shoot up a bit into the air!

STEP #2:

Add several drops of food coloring into the cup/bottle mixture (the more food coloring you add the darker the lava.)

STEP #3:

Place the cup/bottle in the snow and build a snow volcano around the edges. You want to pack the snow right up to the top of the cup/bottle so you can't see it, just make sure you leave the hole at the top for the lava to come out.

STEP #4:

NOW the kids can pour the vinegar in the top of the volcano and watch it erupt. **TIP:** The more vinegar the BIGGER the eruption! You can go ahead and repeat this as desired with more baking soda and vinegar.
